Animal Nursery Rules

1. **Bio Security Clause:** All QCAS affiliated agriculture societies have developed a comprehensive Agriculture Show Biosecurity Plan and all event organizer's, competitors and spectators have a joint responsibility to ensure the successful implementation of the biosecurity plan.

2. **Display Animals**

The Mt Larcom Show Animal Nursery accepts animals for display and will provide water during their stay. (*The owner is to supply all food or feed for their animals.*)

3. The Mt Larcom Show Society (MLDSS) will take no responsibility if the animal/s has a health issue during this show event. If an animal falls ill through the event it will need to be quarantined or removed from the grounds at the owner's expense. Please complete and provide a copy of the Animal Health Declaration form located on our website, these records need to be kept for 7 years by the society and person supplying animals.

4. **Animals for Sale**

The Mt Larcom Show Animal Nursery hires out cages for the use of vendors who wish to display their animals for sale. Information about the price and contact details of the owner should be displayed on the cage.

6. **Dealings with the public**

All dealings with the public for the sale of the animals is to be conducted by the owner and the prospective buyer. The MLDSS will not be responsible or liable in anyway regarding the information given to the buyer or for the arrangements of sale.

7. All Puppies and Kittens under 12 weeks of age must be Vaccinated at least 14 days prior to the show before being able to enter the showgrounds and proof of vaccination is required. This is Mandatory to our Biosecurity Plan.
8. To comply with the mandatory requirements for Biosecurity, the following rules will be in place. All sheep and goats must have an eID tag, for Bobby calves must have a NLIS tag, for pigs a PigPass is required. Upon entry to the showgrounds all livestock will be scanned and recorded as sighted on MLDSS PIC - QECL0639 register.
9. **Waiver:**
I acknowledge that it is a condition of participating in this **Event** that I do so at my own risk. I accept all risks and release the society from all claims, demands and proceedings arising out of or connected with my participation in the Event and indemnify them against all liability for any injury, loss or damage arising out of or connected with my participation in the Event. This release continues forever and binds all my heirs, successors, executors, personal representatives and assigns.
10. I acknowledge that it is a condition of participating in the **Event** that the Society and any person or body directly or indirectly associated with the **Event** are absolved from all liability arising for injury, death or damage to myself or my property howsoever caused arising out of my participation in the **Event** whatsoever whether due to any negligent act, breach of duty, default and/or omission on the part of the society and any person or body directly or indirectly associated with the **Event**, or otherwise.
